SELECTION PROCESS POLICY & PROCEDURE

Player registration

- Player registration shall be received by the Club by the proclaimed date.
- Late registration shall only be accepted with the approval of the Committee.
- The Committee will assess each circumstance on a case by case basis.
- No player, who has not registered, is to be approached to trial after trials have commenced without the permission of the Committee.

Selection

- Only Selectors appointed by the Committee are to be involved in the selection process.
- A minimum of three Selectors shall be appointed per age group.
- A copy of the selection process policy and procedures is to be distributed to each Selector on appointment.
- All Selectors must attend all trials unless injury, illness or prior arrangement with Committee precludes this.
- Selectors are not permitted to discuss selection matters with players, parents or persons not involved in the selection process either during or after selection trials.
- During the selection process, Selectors shall assess each player individually and collectively, taking notice of such attributes as their netball skills, agility, decision making, court awareness and their readiness to compete at a higher level.
- The Selection Panels shall provide a fair and equitable selection process and take the following factors into account
 - performance at trials
 - feedback from previous coaches
 - team balance (according to positions played)
 - scope for improvement
- All triallists are assessed fairly and equitably in the interest of both the Club and the players.
- All players are required to attend trials.
- No player's grading is to be assumed.
- The Club aims to have equitable court time at trials.
- Selectors who have been appointed as a Coach shall judge all players objectively and not be influenced by the possible compilation of 'their' team.
- Should a situation occur where the final selection is not conclusive in more than one team, a squad may be selected to be finalised during the preseason training period.
- Selection of players unable to trial, shall be at the discretion of the Committee provided prior notice is received of the inability to attend trials and the reason is valid (eg overseas, work commitment, injury).

- Players shall be advised that selection following trials is not absolute and review of selection of players is ongoing during training sessions and matches and further player movement may occur during the season.
- Dependent upon circumstance, team requirements, selection review, player court time and player availability, players may be promoted or demoted either temporarily or permanently as per Club requirements.
- Player transition may occur at any time during the season but not to the detriment of player eligibility for finals participation.
